## Inventory: Snare Drum

---

- Elementary School
  - 14" x 5"
- Middle School
  - 14" x 4" + 14" x 5" (amended 04/11 per input from K.S.)
- High School
  - 13" x 3.5" or 14" x 3" (Piccolo)
  - 14" x 4" (amended 04/11 per input from K.S.)
  - 15" x 12" or similar (Field Drum)

## Inventory: Bass Drum

---

- Elementary School
  - 24" x 14" or 28" x 14" or 32" x 16"
- Middle School
  - 32" x 16" or 36" x 16"
- High School
  - 36" x 18" or 36" x 20" or 36" x 22" or larger

## Inventory: Hand Cymbals

---

- Elementary School
  - 12", 13", or 14"
- Middle School
  - 14" or 16"
- High School
  - 16", 17", 18", 19" or 20"
- Zildjian, Sabian, Paiste, Meinl, Koide

# Inventory: Suspended Cymbals

---

- Elementary School
  - 16" or 18"
- Middle School
  - 16" or 18"
- High School
  - 16", 18", 19" + 20"
- Zildjian, Sabian, Paiste, Meinl, Koide

# Inventory: Keyboard Percussion

- Glockenspiel (2.5 octaves or greater\*)
- Xylophone (3.5 octaves or greater\*\*)
- Vibraphone (3.0 octaves or greater)
- Chimes (1.5 octaves)
- Marimba (4.3 octaves or greater\*\*)

\*aluminum bars (sound one octave higher); steel bars (sound two octaves higher)

\*\*synthetic bars recommended for public school setting
